Bring This Catalog to the Auction!

Before auction night, browse the catalog and plan your bidding. Make notes in it ahead of time. Bring it with you to the auction to keep track of items and your bids on them. Bring your calendar too, just in case!

Registration Begins at 5:30

You must register (for free) before the auction starts. The registrar will keep a record of your name and **bidding number** to keep track of your purchases throughout the evening. Spouses/partners should share a number.

Live Auction

The live auction will be a fun, fast and furious way to bid on items. Sean, our auctioneer, will describe items and encourage you to bid. Hold up your number and holler out your bid. Sean's helpers will keep track of the winning bids.

Silent Auction

Bidding in the silent auction takes place on tables and at the windows. Bid sheets allow you to bid, monitor, and re-bid on interesting items. **Use your bidding number—not your name!** Each item is assigned the same number found in this catalog. If someone outbids you, you are encouraged to go back and increase your bid. The silent auction will close table by table, at rolling intervals. Sean will make clear announcements of closing times for each table. (Tables will be identified by the color of the table covers.) Don't want to risk losing out? Bid the guaranteed price on the last row!

Buy-It-Now/Sign-up Price

These donations offer opportunities for several people. The bid sheets for these are also hung on windows and laid out on tables. It's not ordinary "bidding." By entering your **bidding number**, you are committing to pay the stated buy-it-now price. Want to buy another place? Enter your bidding number again on the next line.

Refreshments Comfort Foods With a Twist! and beverages are available in the back of the sanctuary. Complete dinner (\$6 per adult) will be served from 5:30 to around 7:00. Child's plate (ages 12 and under) is just \$3. Dessert will be available at \$2 per slice.

Childcare will be available 5:30 to 8:30. If you want childcare, you must request it (288-9561) by February 14.

Collecting on your Winning Bid

Pick up your food and certificates at the Pick-up Table. Most dinners and entertainment events have a specific date. For other winnings, it is your responsibility to contact the donor and arrange for delivery of the service at a mutually agreed upon time. You need not contact the donor immediately. Unless both parties come to an agreement for an extension, **purchases will be forfeited after one year from tonight.** Keep your catalog for your records to remind you of what you bought and what you donated.

Payments can be made by cash, check or credit card. It takes a few minutes to tally up what everyone owes. Please be patient with us!

Background: Lavita Shelton was a Muncie UU back in the 1960s when she met and invited Julie and Bob Fritz to come to our church. She later moved to Madison, Indiana. The Fritz family is still here, of course, and they keep in close contact with Lavita. So, many thanks to Julie and Bob for arranging this truly special offering!

Lavita has very generously offered to donate to our auction a 5-night and 6-day stay at her Manor House. Ordinarily, she rents out Shelton's Ash Manor Guest House at \$250 per night (that would be \$1,250 for a 5-night stay) plus tax, for the first 1-4 persons, with a \$25 charge per additional guest per night. For our auction, she expects no income from it at all for herself, plus no tax and no extra charge for more than 4 persons (up to a limit of 9 persons in all). To repeat, our church gets to keep all the money that the winning bidder pays!

Staying at the Manor is much like stepping back 200 years in time. No cell phone service, TV, or computer connections. (There is a land line phone with unlimited local and domestic long distance.) It is on 450 hilly acres of Classified Forest and creek bottom farmland that you will want to explore. A mile-long hike leads to the Indian-Kentuck Creek where you can go fishing, swimming, or fossil hunting. Although it is less than 30 years old, the construction, architectural details, and materials would date it as late 18th century. The builder combined the salvaged timbers from three Kentucky log cabins to create this elegant log home, authentic to the late 18th century. It is furnished with antiques that are usable, functional, comfortable, and not untouchable. Well behaved children and pets are welcome.

The manor sleeps up to 9 in 4 bedrooms. All linens, towels, cookware, dishes, silverware, and a washer and dryer are provided. All you have to bring is your food and beverages! The kitchen has a nice electric stove, medium-size refrigerator, microwave oven, mixer, blender, coffee pot, and crockpot. A huge fireplace, complete with crane and cast iron cookware, dominates one end of the kitchen. There are 4 levels, with only the bottom kitchen level being handicapped accessible. The kitchen door opens out onto a back patio with a gas grill, table and 6 chairs, and a long porch swing. There's even a firepit. The living room is on the second level which you enter through the front door. It also features a large fireplace, comfortable seating for everyone, and a sideboard dated 1773 with a coffee pot and electric tea kettle. Many board games and a library are provided. Two bedrooms are on each of the top two levels, one of which has a fireplace.

The one bathroom is on the living room level. It features a slipper tub and a composting toilet. This simply involves doing your business as usual, and putting a dipper of peat moss from the nearby crock in the toilet after each use. (Because of the steep terrain, a septic system could not be installed.) Lavita's Amish friends have built commodes with chamberpots for each of the bedrooms, so no one has to descend the stairs in the night.

Your visit can be any 5 consecutive nights between April 20 (when the wild flowers are breath-taking) and September 15. But not during the July 4th weekend.
